

Baxter County men ready to "do their bit" in WWI

Baxter County's Registration Result

There were 787 names registered in the county of which 516 claims exception. Mountain Home township produced 102 of the list. Everything passed off quietly except a slight disturbance in Buford township but was quickly put in check by the officers. So far as indicated everybody seemed to realize that the nation is passing through a crisis and it would take the concerted action of all to bring the issue at hand to a safe conclusion. Quite a good deal of explanation was compelled to be made by the registrars, and some of those subject to registration had an idea that they would be required to start at once for the training camps. So far as known everyone coming under the Act in this county responded to the call. Some of the boys had already enlisted in both the army and the navy and when the test comes on the field of action the Baxter county boys can be counted on to "do their bit." In the state there were 130,671 names registered of which 11,157 were negroes. There was one negro registered in Baxter County, and he was a transient and happened to be at Norfolk on the day of registration.

When World War I began, the U.S. Army was small compared with the mobilized armies of the European powers. As late as 1914, the federal army was under 100,000, while the National numbered around 115,000.

By late 1916, it had become clear that any participation by the United States in the conflict in Europe would require a far larger army. A draft was envisioned in December 1916 and brought to President Wilson's attention shortly after the break in relations with Germany in February 1917. Though opposed at first, Wilson accepted the recommendation by Secretary of War Newton Baker for a draft.

*The **Selective Service Act** or **Selective Draft Act** enacted May 18, 1917 authorized the federal government to raise a national army for the American entry into World War I through the compulsory enlistment of people. Though a draft is never popular, as the names listed on these pages shows, the men of Baxter patriotically responded. Of course, most of these were not actually called to served— but they registered.*
